The "sermon" will be based on the life of John Newton, author of the world famous song "Amazing Grace".

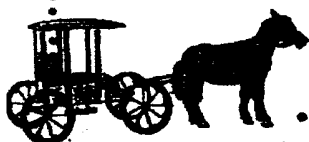
**Music will be provided by the River Ridge String Band** as we sing-along to some lively gospel songs. Music sponsored by Dulle Trimble Funeral Home
