The honor recognizes exterior projects of:

- **Renovation** - a project designed to refresh, upgrade and maintain a building exterior.
- **Restoration** - a project that restored the original appearance of the building.

Nominated projects should enhance the overall use and appearance of the building. Routine maintenance is not considered restoration/renovation work for the purposes of this award. Nominated projects must involve homes/buildings that are at least 50 years old and are located in the City of Jefferson. The work project must have been done in the last five years and must be completed.
